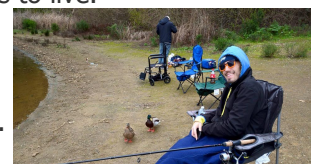

Update On Alex

HCF started sponsoring Alex in November 2015. For the past 4 years, Alex has been battling Osteosarcoma. His cancer is terminal. He has had over 22 surgeries on his leg, lungs, and mid-section. He suffered through numerous rounds of aggressive chemotherapy, but the cancer continues to return. In November of 2014, Alex was given only two weeks to live.

Today, he still battles cancer and is getting chemotherapy every 2 weeks lasting for a total of 5 days. These chemotherapy treatments are quite debilitating. Alex spends his time reading books and playing video games. Occasionally, he has the energy to go out and be with friends. He looks

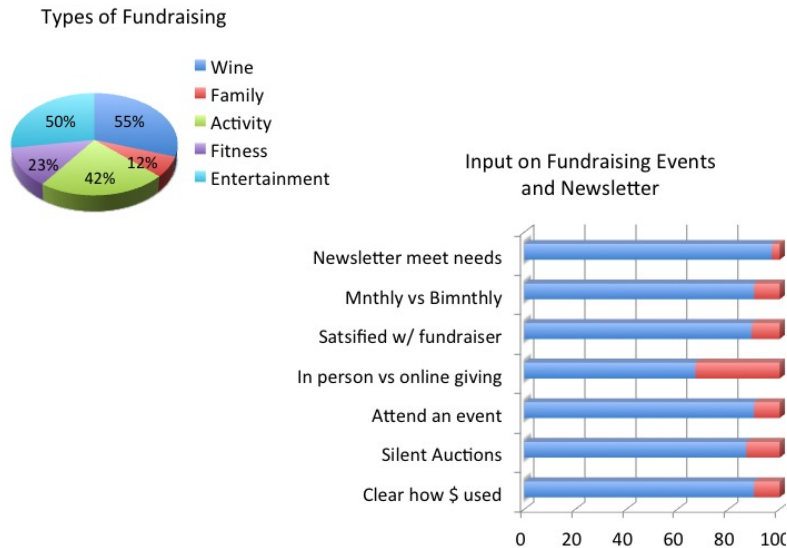
